## Who, When, What, Where and Other Details

**WHO:** Anyone who plays a concert band instrument, SVers and friends/family. People new to the group need to be pretty quick at learning music, as we have only 5 rehearsals.

**WHEN: Rehearsals:** June 3, 10, 17, 24, July 1, 6:45-8:15 PM.

**Concert:** Thursday, July 2 - Wayland COA summer concert series, 6:30 call for 7:00 outdoor concert at the Wayland COA/Community Center (8 Andrew Ave., Wayland).

**WHAT:** Summer Band: 5 rehearsals and a performance (6 sessions).

**WHERE:** Rehearsals will be indoors in the Wayland Community Center and the concert will be outdoors, near the parking lot. **BRING A MUSIC STAND. Chairs provided.**

**CONCERT:** "Celebrating America in Music" - July 2<sup>nd</sup>, outdoors at the Wayland COA/Community Center, part of the Wayland COA summer concert series

**MUSIC:** We will be playing 9 or 10 pieces for our outdoor concert on July 2nd, to be chosen from the following (most are fairly easy):

- ♪ Sousa's Golden Jubilee March (simplified; original played in Fall 2023)
- ♪ Cohan Cavalcade (revised; original played in summers 2016 & 2025)
- ♪ Selections from the Music Man (spring 2009, fall 2015, spring 2017)
- ♪ Yankee Doodle/Chester (Spring 2011; summers 2011, 12, 13, 14, 15)
- ♪ Wheatland (Fall 2025)
- ♪ Appalachian Morning (spring 2026)
- ♪ Louis Armstrong (spring 2026)
- ♪ Ragtimeout (new)
- ♪ Polka Party (spring 2026)
- ♪ Shenandoah (Spring 2008; summer 2023)
- ♪ Amazing Grace (Fall 2013; several summers)
- ♪ Barnum & Bailey's Favorite (Spring 2014; summer 2018)
- ♪ Take Me Out to the Ball Game (permanent folder; many summers)
- ♪ "America the Beautiful" from American Folk Song Celebration (summers 2024 & 2025)

Once the music is ready, you will find your parts in the same dropbox for your instrument where you accessed other SV music. We'll send out an email and let you know when the summer music is available in the dropbox. Any questions or problems, please email Diane.

## OTHER DETAILS

**Cost:** \$100 for all 6 sessions or \$20 per session drop-in – cash or check.

**Registration:** is through SVNHM, NOT LS Adult Ed (they don't have a summer program).

**Bring to rehearsals:** Bring your music stand, instrument, music, pencil, & love of making music!  
Brass and other instruments that drip water – also please bring a rag or something to empty on.

**Restroom access:** Yes!

**Food:** We will be having a short time after rehearsal for snacks and social time. Each section will have a week assigned for people to bring snacks if they would like to. More info to come!

**Arrival:** You may arrive any time after 6:20 and hang out to chat at the end of rehearsal. If you are able, please help us put away chairs after rehearsal.

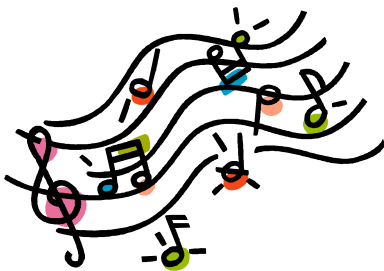
